## Report 1: Overview

### ■ Preamble

As a liberal arts university, Lingnan is fully committed to teaching quality, but we also consider that research is equally important for academic staff. This is in line with Lord Sutherland's Report that "all university level teachers are expected to be engaged in research and scholarship" (p.3). Lingnan's research profile since the 1999 Research Assessment Exercise (RAE) has been impressive. From an RAE Index of 38.85% in 1999, the figure surged to 67.9% in an Internal RAE conducted in 2003 by six external members selected from other sister UGC-funded institutions. Same 1999 UGC threshold standards were used in the 2003 Internal RAE at Lingnan.

As mentioned in our annual report last year, according to the survey's results published by the *Hong Kong Economic Journal Monthly* (HKEJM) in its October 2003 issue, Lingnan ranked first among the eight UGC institutions for the quality of our teaching, and fourth overall after The Chinese University of Hong Kong, The University of Hong Kong and The Hong Kong University of Science & Technology. Notwithstanding its short history, our Department of Economics, as reported in the January 2005 issue of *HKEJM*, came third in a survey of the academic performance of the economics departments of seven Hong Kong universities, evaluation of which was based on the number of articles per capita published by the universities' academic staff in quality international economics journals as well as the number of Competitive Earmarked Research Grants awarded by the Research Grants Council per full-time academic staff member. In the Philosophy Lists Evaluative Survey of Graduate Philosophy Departments (<http://www.philosophylists.info/GraduateDepartments.html>; the lists ranks 711 philosophy departments world wide and leaves 243 departments unranked) the Lingnan Philosophy Department was ranked #157, while the HKU department was ranked #242 and the CUHK Department #478 (<http://www.philosophylists.info/GraduateDepartmentsbyCountry.html>). Such ranking lists are of course having their limitations, but the Philosophy Lists have a set of fairly well defined criteria that enable one to see what the rankings are based on.

The above survey results demonstrate convincingly that the University is staffed by well-qualified academics, and enjoys a growing reputation both at home

and internationally. Articles written by our staff had appeared in premier journals, and books have often been published by prestigious academic presses internationally. It is no exaggeration to say that research outputs and scholarly activities of our academic staff in the past few years have successfully put Lingnan University on the global academic map.

## ■ Institutional Policy on Research

Striking an appropriate balance between teaching and research is central to the University's approach to the development of a research culture. While teaching is our primary mission, research is seen as a vital element of scholarly activity which supports and enriches teaching.

The University's research policy is designed to optimize the use of research funds through quality enhancement, focused development and collaborative endeavour. Quality enhancement is achieved through faculty appointment and continuing improvement of its existing staff profile. Focused development is achieved as a result of identification of areas of excellence and the recruitment of faculty to build up strength in these areas. Collaborative endeavour is fostered by establishing research centres that provide both research support and coordination.

## ■ Quality Enhancement

To ensure that faculty members will be given adequate opportunities to engage in research and development activities as well as a concentrated period for writing, a study leave scheme that awards a maximum time-off period from 6-12 months has been put in place. This will allow academic staff, through re-arrangements of teaching schedule and utilization of the summer vacation, to be released from teaching and administrative duties to concentrate on research/study/writing full time. Altogether, seven academic members from six departments were released from teaching in 2004-05, each for a six-month period.

In addition to their regular participation in academic seminars organized by local tertiary institutions, staff are administratively encouraged and financially supported by the University to attend scholarly activities overseas to keep abreast of the latest developments in their respective fields of expertise. During the year under review, the University was able to commit HK\$0.8 million to support

conference and other staff-development activities. A total of 77 academic papers were presented, through which staff were (and will continue to be) able to share the results of their research with local or overseas specialists, and to receive the feedback required before making their research more generally available in a published form.

## ■ **Focused Development**

Lingnan is fully aware of the need to focus its research efforts on its areas of strength. At Lingnan, research and teaching are seen as interactive, one enriching the other field of endeavour. The synergy between teaching and research is particularly relevant to Lingnan, as our teaching exhibits a strong empirical orientation.

A total of eight priority research areas have been identified for focused support, namely: Aesthetics and Theories of the Arts, Cultural Research and Development, Managerial and Organisational Issues in Chinese Mainland, Modern Literature in Chinese, Public Humanities, Public Policy, Social Gerontology and Taxation. All these research areas are in line with our liberal arts mission, and are selected based on the existing strengths and proven track records, as well as their connectivity to the undergraduate teaching.

## ■ **Collaborative Endeavour**

There are a number of active research units at the University, including the Institute of Humanities & Social Sciences (comprising the Asia-Pacific Institute of Ageing Studies, Centre for Asian Pacific Studies, Centre for Humanities Research, Centre for Public Policy Studies and Kwan Fong Cultural Research & Development Programme) and the Hong Kong Institute of Business Studies. These research units continue to undertake multi-dimensional research in various disciplinary and interdisciplinary areas. We also make an active effort to recruit international scholars to engage in joint research with our staff so as to increase the international profile of our academic research. Scholars visiting the University during the reporting year include Professor Guofu Tan from the University of Southern California, Professor Siu L. Chow and Dr Stuart Wilson from the University of Regina, Professor Alan Walker from the University of Sheffield, Professor Alun E Joseph from the University of Guelph, Professor Fujii Shozo

from Tokyo University, and Professor Ikegami Sadako from Atomi University.

In 2004-2005, the University set aside a sum of HK\$135,000 to finance two-way academic-exchange activities between institutions of higher learning on the Mainland and Lingnan. A total of ten incoming and five outgoing visits were supported by this Academic Exchanges with China Scheme. Visiting institutions included Shanghai University of Finance & Economics, Fudan University, Peking University, Nankai University, among others.

## ■ Organization of Research Funding

The Research and Postgraduate Studies Committee (RPSC) is charged with the formulation of policies for the promotion, conduct, supervision and funding of research in the University. It decides on all internal funding allocations and monitors progress of research projects on various grants. Research Panels at the Programme level undertake initial assessment of applications for research grants and make funding recommendations to the RPSC. The Office of Research and Staff Development provides administrative assistance to the Committee in the management of allocated grants to ensure that all funding and budgetary procedures are properly followed.

The University aims to support as many worthwhile research projects as possible where reasonable research thresholds are attained. Internal research grants are allocated on the basis of competitive bids. Each application is evaluated on the basis of its academic merit, feasibility within the indicated time frame, budgetary appropriateness, and the track record of the investigator(s).

## ■ Usage of Direct Allocation Grant

During the year, the RPSC allocated HK\$2.3 million to support a total of 47 research projects, involving about 30% of our academic staff. As in the past, the RPSC allocated 35% of its research budget directly to Academic Programmes as a start-up grant to support projects costing up to HK\$30,000 each without referral to the RPSC for approval. The titles and grants for those projects funded from the University's Block Grant and the RGC's Direct Allocation Grant are set out in Reports 2A and 2B respectively. Projects supported from private sources are listed in Report 2C.

## ■ The Way Forward

The research performance of Lingnan's academic staff and its strategy of focusing on priority research areas with limited resources are best summed up by the RGC delegation to Lingnan in June 2005: "Overall, Members were impressed with the research productivity of the faculty in Arts, Social Sciences and Business Studies and were pleased to see that the decision to focus on priority areas had clearly paid off. This evident research productivity was especially impressive in the light of the heavy teaching loads at the university. Members also noted that many of the most productive scholars occupied key administrative posts, and appreciated very much the way that these colleagues managed well the balance between the educational and research missions of LU."

We believe that an adequately funded research base is essential to our institutional well-being, in particular our liberal arts curriculum. As external funding for "non-laboratory" research in the areas of Humanities, Social Sciences and Business (in which we are active) is extremely limited in terms of the schemes and total funds available, we need the UGC/RGC to increase research support in these areas to enable us to build up our research strength and infrastructure. In this connection, we welcome the RGC's proposal to establish a new Sub-Panel to address the special needs of Humanities projects that require support to free up PI's staff time. We consider that it is an important step in the right direction.

#### **1 *Scholarly books, monographs and chapters***

- 11 *Research book or monograph (author)* – Authored work generally arising from academic research project(s) although contract research can produce such results if findings are in the public domain
- 12 *Chapter in an edited book (author)* – A paper, essay, or other material authored specifically for inclusion in an edited book; does not include an opening or summary chapter prepared by an editor for inclusion in a work counted in (14)
- 13 *Textbook (author)* – A full-length authored work used for instructional purposes; include revisions if they involve "substantial" (say 20%) new material
- 14 *Edited book (editor)* – an edited book of essays, research papers or the equivalent

#### **2 *Journal publications***

- 21 *Publication in refereed journal* – A paper in a refereed journal devoted to reporting the results of basic or applied research

2.    The fraction appearing in the "Weighting" column of those co-authored items denotes the weighting of the authors concerned, calculated on a pro-rata basis. For example, a paper with four authors will count as 0.25 for each author, and if three of the four authors are staff members in the same cost centre, the paper will count as  $3 \times 0.25 = 0.75$  in the cost-centre total.
