Rémy Herrera is an economist and researcher at the National Centre for Scientific Research at the University of Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne, France. He has taught at various universities in France (Paris [1993-2013], in particular) and abroad, including the Faculty of Social Sciences of Aleppo (1998), the University of Cairo (1999-2000) and the Universidad Complutense de Madrid (2009-2013). He is associated with the Union of Radical Political Economists (New York), the International Institute for Promoting Political Economy (London), the Sociedad Latinoamericana de Economía Política (Sko Pardo), the Asociación Nacional de Economistas de Cuba (Havana) and the Forum du Tiers-Monde (Third World Forum, Dakar). He works regularly with the Centre Europe - Tiers Monde (Geneva), supporting it in its advisory role to the Council of the United Nations Human Rights (UN).
